PRAYER STUDY #12

ANGELS

For He shall give His angels charge over thee, to keep in all thy ways.

Psalm 91:11

- 1. How many angels are there? Scripture is not clear about this except that there are multitudes. Early church father Thomas Acquinas believed every person on earth had an angel. That would be 5.5 Billion people today. Scripture does teach us that 1/3 of the angels were deceived and fell with Satan and became demons and evil spirits, etc. Daniel 7:10, Matthew 26:23, Revelation 5:11, Revelation 1:3-9
- 2. What do angels look like? Job 38:4-6, Daniel 10:1-18, Ezekiel 24:9-10
- 3. Where do angels live and what do we mean by the third heaven? 2nd Corinthians 12:2, Jude 9
- 4. Can we distinguish one heaven from another? Genesis 1:26, Isaiah 13:10, Revelation 4:7
- 5. **Does the Bible teach the existence of guardian angels?** Yes, although id does not use that specific term. Psalm 91:11, Matthew 18:10
- 6. Can we contact angels? Yes. Jesus said to the companion who sought to protect Him from the soldiers of the high priest, "Put your sword back in its place...Do you think I cannot call on my Father, and He will...put at my disposal more than twelve legions of angels" (Matthew 26:52-53). It is the Father in heaven who hears our cry for help, who commands His waiting angels to contact us. We can only contact angels through Him. They are His messengers, His servants, not ours unless He commands.

We read in the Old Testament of Hagar's little son Ishmael crying, as he was dying of thirst in the parched desert. "God heard the boy crying and the angel of God called to Hagar from Heaven and said to her... 'Do not be afraid...' Then God opened her eyes and she saw a well of water..." (Genesis 21:17-19). She did not ask an angel to help her. God heard her cry for help and He sent an angel.
