## **33 THINGS THE HOLY SPIRIT DOES**

(taken from the May 2013 Edition of *Charisma* Magazine)

- **1. He helps us.** ROMANS 8:26: Likewise the Spirit also helps us in out weaknesses. For we do not know what we should pray for as we ought, but the Spirit Himself makes intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered.
- 2. He guides us. JOHN 16:13: "However, when He, the Spirit of truth, has come, He will guide you into all truth: for He will speak on His own authority, but whatever He hears He will speak; and He will tell you things to come."
- **3.** He teaches us. JOHN 14:26: "But the Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in My name, He will teach you all things, and bring to your remembrance all things that I said to you."
- **4. He speaks.** REVELATION 2:7: *"He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches. To him who overcomes I will give to eat from the tree of life, which is in the midst of the Paradise of God."*
- **5.** He reveals. 1<sup>st</sup> CORINTHIANS 2:9-10: But as it is written: "Eye has not seen, nor ear heard, nor have entered in to the heart of man the things which God has prepared for those who love Him. *But God has revealed them to us through His Spirit. For the Spirit searches all things, yes, the deep things of God.*
- **6. He instructs.** ACTS 8:29: *Then the Spirit said to Philip, "Go near and overtake this chariot."*
- 7. He testifies of Jesus. JOHN 15:26: "But when the Helper comes, whom I shall send to you from the Father, the Spirit of truth who proceeds from the Father, He will testify of Me."
- 8. He comforts us. ACTS 9:31: Then the churches throughout all Judea, Galilee, and Samaria had peace and were edified. And walking in the fear of the Lord and in the comfort of the Holy Spirit, they were multiplied.
- **9. He calls us.** ACTS 13:2: *As they ministered to the Lord and fasted, the Holy Spirit said, "Now separate to Me Barnabas and Saul for the work to which I have called them."*

- **10.He fills us.** ACTS 4:31: And when they had prayed, the place where they were assembled together was shaken; and they were all filled with the Holy Spirit, and they spoke the word of God with boldness.
- **11.He strengthens us.** EPHESIANS 3:14-16: For this reason I bow my knees to the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, from whom the whole family in heaven and earth is named, that He would grant you, according to the riches of His glory, to be strengthened with might through His Spirit in the inner man...
- **12.He prays for us.** ROMANS 8:26: Likewise the Spirit also helps in our weaknesses. For we do not know what we should pray for as we ought, but the Spirit Himself makes intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered.
- **13.He prophesies through us.** 2<sup>ND</sup> PETER 1:19-21: And so we have the prophetic word confirmed, which you do well to heed as a light that shines in a dark place, until the day dawns and the morning star rises in your hearts; knowing this first, that no prophecy of Scripture is of any private interpretation, for prophecy never came by the will of man, but holy men of God spoke as they were moved by the Holy Spirit.
- **14.He bears witness to the truth.** ROMANS 9:1-2: I tell the truth in Christ, I am not lying, my conscience also bearing me witness in the Holy Spirit that I have great sorrow and continual grief in my heart.
- **15.He brings joy.** 1<sup>ST</sup> THESSALONIANS 1:6: And you became followers of us and of the Lord, having received the word in much affliction, with joy of the Holy Spirit.
- **16.He brings freedom.** 2<sup>ND</sup> CORINTHIANS 3:17: Now the Lord is the Spirit; and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is liberty.
- **17.He helps us to obey.** 1<sup>ST</sup> PETER 1:22: Since you have purified your souls in obeying the truth through the Spirit in sincere love of the brethren, love one another fervently with a pure heart.
- **18.He calls for Jesus' return.** REVELATION 22:17: And the Spirit and the bride say, "Come!" And let him who hears say, "Come!" And let him who thirsts come. Whoever desires, let him take the water of life freely.
- **19.He transforms us.** 2<sup>ND</sup> CORINTHIANS 3:18: But we all, with unveiled face, beholding as in a mirror the glory of the Lord, are being transformed into the same image from glory to glory, just as the Spirit of the Lord.
- **20.He lives in us.** 1<sup>ST</sup> CORINTHIANS 3:16: Do you not know that you are the temple of God and that the Spirit of God dwells in you?

- **21.He frees us.** ROMANS 8:2: For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus has made me free from the law of sin and death.
- **22.He renews us.** TITUS 3:4-6: But when the kindness and the love of God our Savior toward man appeared, not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to His mercy he saved us, through the washing of regeneration and renewing of the Holy Spirit, whom he poured out on us abundantly through Jesus Christ our Savior....
- **23.He produces fruit in us.** GALATIANS 5:22-23: But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self control. Against such there is no law.
- **24.He gives gifts.** 1<sup>ST</sup> CORINTHIANS 12:7-10: But the manifestation of the Spirit is given to each one for the profit of all: for to one is given the word of wisdom through the Spirit, to another the word of knowledge through the same Spirit, to another faith by the same Spirit, to another gifts of healings by the same Spirit, to another the working of miracles, to another prophecy, to another discerning of spirits, to another different kinds of tongues, to another the interpretation of tongues.
- **25.He leads us.** ROMANS 8:14: *For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, these are sons of God.*
- **26.He convicts.** John 16:8: *"And when He has come, He will convict the world of sin and of righteousness and of judgment."*
- **27.He sanctifies us.** 2<sup>nd</sup> THESSALONIANS 2:13: But we are bound to give thanks to God always for you, brethren beloved by the Lord, because God from the beginning chose you for salvation through sanctification by the Spirit and belief in the truth.
- **28.He empowers us.** ACTS 1:8: "But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth."
- **29.He unites us.** EPHESIANS 4:1-6: Therefore, the prisoner of the Lord beseech you to walk worthy of the calling with which you were called, with all lowliness and gentleness, with longsuffering, bearing with one another in love, endeavoring to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace. There is one body and on Spirit, just as you were called in one hope of your calling; one Lord, one faith, one baptism; one God and Father of all, who is above all, and through all, and in you all.
- **30.He seals us.** EPHESIANS 1:13: In Him you also trusted, after you heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation; in whom also, having believed, you were sealed with the Holy Spirit of promise....

- **31.He gives us access to the Father.** EPHESIANS 2:17-18: And he came and preached to you who were afar off and to those who were near. For through Him we both have access by one Spirit to the Father. Now, therefore, you are no longer strangers and foreigners, but fellow citizens with the saints and members of the household of God.
- **32.He enables us to wait.** GALATIANS 5:5: For we through the Spirit eagerly wait for the hope of righteousness by faith.
- **33.He casts out demons.** MATTHEW 12:28: "But if I cast out demons by the Spirit of God, surely the kingdom of God has come upon you."
