CONCLUSION OF THE BAPTISM IN THE HOLY SPIRIT STUDY

We must ask the Lord to fill us with His Spirit and submit every part of us-spirit, soul and body-past, present, and future to the Lord. We begin to magnify the Lord in praise, and we receive by faith. If we truly desire and truly surrender, we will receive. Sometimes the manifestation is not immediately evident, but it will come.

The Baptism is necessary if we are going to be a real threat to the kingdom of darkness, but it is not a stopping place. We must go on to maturity and constantly be refilled. The Lord designed us to be leaky vessels so that we could pour out on others, but that means we ourselves must continually go before Him and ask for more of Him each day.

We have seen people try to coach people in speaking in tongues. We also see many ministers who feel they must help the Holy Spirit out and both pressure people to receive and push people over. This might temporarily make the minister look "spiritual" but it leaves the person being ministered to disappointed in the long term results because the experience was not really real. The Holy Spirit does not need our help. He will stir the hearts of those who seek this experience. If there are blockages such as unforgiveness or unconfessed sin areas, the Holy Spirit will show a genuine seeker these blockages so they can be taken care of. When they desire more of Him and seek Him with a pure heart, they will receive.

I believe the Lord is calling even now a spirit baptized, Remnant Company, which will contain people from all over the world and will be the Church of the Last Days, which will do exploits for Jesus. I thought of the church in Laodicea. I believe that we are living in the Laodicean age now. The Church is deceived about its condition and says, "...I am rich and increased with goods and have need of nothing" (Revelation 3:17).

I heard the Lord speak to me again. This time He said that many in America had already spiritually passed the point of no return. They had rejected Christ, and they had closed their hearts to the Gospel message. They had been given over to a reprobate mind because they refused to turn to Jesus, and they worshiped the creature, the human body, more than the Creator (Romans 1).

All of this made me very sad in the spirit, but it also made me feel a real urgency about the times in which we live. We have got to get the Gospel message out to the highways and byways so that we can turn the hearts of those who *will* listen to Jesus. Time is running out. It is the Baptism in the Holy Spirit which gives us power.

We were once a godly nation who sent more Christian missionaries to other countries than any other nation in the world. We once were the greatest lending nation in history but in just a few short years have become, most likely, the most indebted nation in the world. To most Americans, it is sheer lunacy that Communist China holds most of our debt. Because of political expediency, we continue to buy from this country, which has a terrible human rights record and persecutes the Church of Jesus Christ. We continue to send aid money to our enemies and make treaties with those who hate us. We have gained a reputation in the world for giving to our enemies and double-crossing our friends.

I believe that there is a demonic principality of confusion over our nation's capitol. So much of what our politicians are doing today makes no sense to common, everyday Americans. Our leaders seem confused and out of touch with the values of most Americans.

Our economy is in the final throes of death. No one, except God, can save us now. In spite of what the politicians and the left-leaning liberals say, we have been a nation called by His name. We have been known throughout the world as *Christian* America, and He has blessed us, as a Christian nation, beyond anything the world has ever seen. If a handful of people can stop prayer in schools and permit abortion on demand, then a handful of people with God's power can turn America around before it is too late. I believe this Remnant Company could spark another great awakening in our land, similar to the Charles Finney revival meetings. Finney was a revivalist in the 1800s and saw entire towns turn to Jesus.

Even at the darkest hour, there is always hope in Jesus. Even today, in spite of the mess we are in, I see a generation coming forth who will seek His face more than His hand and who is ready to lay everything down to follow Jesus and to bring His Kingdom on the earth as it is in heaven. This generation will walk in the power of the Holy Spirit much like the first century disciples did, following the outpouring of the Spirit on the Day of Pentecost.

Jesus is coming back just like He said, and all the world will behold Him. I believe that His coming will be sooner than most American theologians think. World events could happen and final prophecies be fulfilled so quickly that we could come to that very hour during my lifetime.

How can we live in fear when we know He is coming back for us? There should be great expectancy and longing for Him and peace in our hearts as

we meditate on the fact that we are His, no matter what happens on earth in the days ahead. The Remnant Company will be ready and waiting for the Second Coming and will often rejoice in the last promise that Jesus gave in the Word of God, Revelation 22:20: "He who testifieth these things saith, Surely I come quickly.
