“Be still and know that I am God.”

PSALMS 46:10

1. **Signs of the time show us that it is later than we think.**
2. **We are running to and fro, too busy for the Lord, with a Martha spirit.**
3. **The Lord is calling us to be still and wait before Him in the spirit of Mary.**

A Few of the Scriptural Signs of the Last Days

Daniel 12:4-But thou, O Daniel, shut up the words, and seal the book, even to the times of the end; many shall run to and fro, and knowledge shall be increased.

Matthew 24:7-For nation shall rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom, and there shall be famines and pestilences and earthquakes in various places.

Matthew 24:12-And because iniquity shall abound, the love of many shall grow cold.

1st Timothy 4:1-Now the Spirit speaketh expressly that, in the latter times, some shall depart from the faith, giving heed to seducing spirits, and doctrines of demons...

Jude 18-21-How they told you there should be mockers in the last time, who should walk after their own ungodly lusts. These are they who separate themselves, sensual, having not the Spirit. But ye, beloved, building up yourselves on your most holy faith, praying in the Holy Spirit, keep yourselves in the love of God, looking for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ unto eternal life.

2nd Timothy 3:1-5(Living Bible)-You may as well know this too, Timothy, that in the last days it is going to be very difficult to be a Christian. For people will love only themselves and their money; they will be proud and boastful, sneering at God, disobedient to their parents, ungrateful to them, and thoroughly bad. They will be hardheaded and never give in to others; they will be constant liars and troublemakers and will think nothing of immorality. They will be rough and cruel, and sneer at those who try to be good. They will betray their friends; they will be hotheaded, puffed up with pride, and prefer good times to worshipping God. They will go to church, yes, but they won't really believe anything they hear. Don't be taken in by people like that.

Isaiah 34:8-For it is the day of the Lord's vengeance, and the year of recompenses for the controversy of Zion.

BE STILL AND WAIT

If as it were for a little moment, until the indignation be past. For, behold, the Psalm 46:10-Be still, and know that I am God. I will be exalted among the nations. I will be exalted in the earth.

(Daniel 11:32b-...but the people that do know their God shall be strong and do exploits.)

Psalm 1:1-3-Blessed is the man who walketh not in the counsel of the ungodly nor standeth in the way of sinners, nor sitteth in the seat of the scornful. But his delight is in the law of the law and in His law doeth he meditate day and night. And he shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that bringeth forth its fruit in its season; its leaf also shall not wither; and whatsoever he doeth shall prosper.

2nd Chronicles 19:15 & 17- ...Thus saith the Lord unto you, "Be not afraid nor dismayed by reason of this great multitude; for the battle is not yours, but God's.....You shall not need to fight in this battle; set yourselves, STAND YE STILL, and see the salvation of the Lord with you, O Judah and Jerusalem.

Psalm 25:5-Lead me in thy truth, and teach me; for thou art the God of my salvation; on thee do I wait all the day.

Psalm 27:14-Wait on the Lord; be of good courage, and He shall strengthen your heart. Wait, I say, on the Lord.

Psalm 37:9-For evildoers shall be cut off, but those who wait upon the Lord shall inherit the earth.

Isaiah 40:31-But they that wait upon the Lord shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings like eagles; they shall run, and not be weary; and they shall walk and not faint.

Lamentations 3:26-It is good that a man should both hope and quietly wait for the salvation of the Lord.

Micah 7:7-Therefore, I will look upon the Lord; I will wait for the God of my salvation; my God will hear me.

Isaiah 26:20-21-Come, my people, enter thou into thy chambers, and shut thy doors about thee; hide thyself as it were for a little moment, until the indignation is past. For behold, the Lord cometh out of His place to punish the inhabitants of the earth for their iniquity; the earth also shall disclose her blood, and shall no more cover her slain.

Psalm 2:12-Kiss the Son, lest He be angry, and ye perish from the way, when His wrath is kindled but a little. Blessed are all they who put their trust in Him.
