PRAYER STUDY #93 HOPE

But sanctify the Lord God in your hearts, and be ready always to give an answer to every man that asketh you a reason for **the hope that is in you**, with meekness and fear... 1st Peter 3:15

The two main sources of the hope that is in you:

A. IN HIS NAME-I will praise you forever for what you have done; in your name I will hope, for your name is good. I will praise you in the presence of your saints. Psalm 52:9 In His name the nations will put their hope. Matthew 12:21

Until John 14, according to Andrew Murray, "the disciples had not asked in the Name of Christ, nor had He Himself ever used the expression....Here in His parting words, He repeats the word unceasingly in connection with those promises of unlimited meaning, *Whatsoever, Anything, What you will,* to teach them <u>and us!</u> that His Name is our *only*, but also our *all sufficient* plea. The power and the answer depend upon the right use of the name."

The Name of the Lord:

- 1. Lets joy come to the believer-Psalm 5:11, 33:21
- 2. Is the Lord's defense against enemies-Psalm 20:1, 44:5
- 3. Gives the Lord's inheritance to the believer-Psalm 61:5
- 4. Causes us to dwell in Zion-Psalm 69:35-36
- 5. Purges us from our sin-Psalm 79:9
- 6. Brings deliverance-Psalm 79:9
- 7. Expedites an answer from the Lord-Psalm 99:6
- 8. Blesses those who come in His Name-Psalm 118:26a
- 9. Helps us keep His law-Psalm 119:55
- 10.Brings the Lord's Mercy-Psalm 119:132
- 11. Helps the believer in times of trouble-Psalm 124:8
- 12.Cast out demons-Mark 16:17

4. JEHOVAH RAPHA: The Lord, our Healer-Exodus 15:26

5. JEHOVAH NISSI: The Lord, our Banner or Victor-Exodus 17:15

6. JEHOVAH MCKADDESH: The Lord, our Sanctifier-Leviticus 20:8

Remember that as these names were given to physical Israel in the Old Testament, New Testament believers-i.e., *you and I*-are spiritual Israel(see 1st Corinthians 10, Ephesians 2:12, Galatians 6:16), and ALL THAT JEHOVAH WAS TO THEM, JESUS IS TO US. I would encourage you to call on these names to fit your particular need. For example, pray to Him as Jehovah Rapha when you need a healing or Jehovah Jireh when you need provision.

B. IN HIS WORD: I rise before dawn and cry for help; I have put my hope in your word. Psalm 119:147

"We believe God's Word and know it is TRUE. Jeremiah 1:12 says God watches over His Word to perform it, and Isaiah 55:11 says His Word will not return to Him void, but will accomplish what it is sent to do. Knowing this, we can pray the Word about a situation and expect God-kind of results. The person we pray for has a free choice whether to accept what God has for them, and, by praying the Word on their behalf, we give them the benefit of choosing either life or death, blessing or cursing, going God's way or their own way(Deuteronomy 30:19). As we confess His Word, believe it, read it, speak it, and act on it, we begin to merge with it, and it becomes our way of life. As we live the Word, His strength, His ability, His peace, His love, His joy, His confidence and His faith become ours. As we pray His Word, the weary ones, the weak ones, the deceived ones, the sick ones will be ministered to, protected by and brought gently to our Good Shepherd."

Special WORD Scriptures

- 1. Psalm 119 is the longest chapter in the Bible with 176 verses(all but just a couple refer to the Word of God). Verse 9 tells us that the Word cleanses us(This is typed by the brazen laver filled with water with which the priest washed himself in the Old Testament Tabernacles). Verse 24 tells us that the Word is our counselor. Verse 105 tells us that the Word is our guide. Verse 165 tells us that the Word gives us peace.
- 2. Psalm 107:20: *He sent His Word and healed them and delivered them from all their destructions.* Matthew 8:8
- 3. Parable of the sower: Mark 4 and Luke 8: Now the parable is this: The seed is the Word of God. Those by the wayside are they that hear; then cometh the devil and taketh away the Word out of their hearts, lest they should believe and be saved. They on the rocks are they who, when they hear, receive the Word with joy, and these have no root, who for a while believe, and in time of testing fall away. And that which fell among thorns are they who, when they have heard, go forth and are chocked with cares and riches and pleasures of this life, and bring no fruit to perfection. But that on the good ground are they who, in an honest and good heart, having heard the Word, keep it and bring forth fruit with patience.
- 4. John 1:1: In the beginning was the Word and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.
- 5. Ephesians 6:17: ... the Sword of the Spirit, which is the Word of God.

- **C. YOUR BLAMELESS WAYS:** Should not your piety be your confidence and your blameless ways your hope? Job 4:6
- **D. NOT FORGETTING GOD:** Such is the destiny of all who forget God; so perishes the hope of the godless. Job 8:13
- **E. THE LORD:** Be strong and take heart, all you who hope in the Lord. Psalm 31:24
- **F. HIS UNFAILING LOVE:** But the eyes of the Lord are on those who fear Him, on those whose hope is in His unfailing love. Psalm 33:18

Hebrews 11:1-Now faith is being sure of what we hope for and certain of what we do not see.

1 John 3:3- Everyone who has this hope in him purifies himself, just as he is pure.
